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




The institution is directed to submit the resolution of the society in this regard. ➤ The Secretary, Droan Education Society vide its letter dated 08.12.2015 and 14.07.2022 has requested for change of name of the institution from Droan B.Ed.College, Rudrapur to Droan College of Education and Technology, Rudrapur.
