

No. 127/22 the Committee made following observations:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Copy of accession register of library not submitted.</li> <li>2. Certified copy of land documents not submitted.</li> <li>3. BCC as submitted by the petitioner-institution does not bear the signature of the competent authority.</li> <li>4. As far as the requirement of composite is concerned, it should be noted that the institution has not submitted any proof towards composite which is a mandatory requirement as per regulation 2(b and 8.1)of regulation 2014.asper clause 7.10 and7.11 the committee can relax any clause (now the institution should be Multidisciplinary as per NEP-2020 which is implemented by Govt. of India on 29<sup>th</sup> July 2020 and has become a part of regulation as per gazette, notification 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2021). However, in the light of directions passed by Hon'ble High court in various orders, the committee has decided to NOT PRESS the requirement for composite structure subject to the statutory remedy of appeal/Review and judicial orders, if any.</li> </ol> <p><b>Hence, final Show Cause Notice be issued under section 14/15(3(b) of the NCTE Act, 1993 to the institution to submit reply within 30 days from the date of issue of show cause notice.</b></p>
<b>The following issues were taken up with the direction of Chairperson NRC.</b>				
3.	--	Decision on appeal relating to matters of composite nature of institutions Shivam college of education Ambika college of education And other cases of similar nature	---	<p>The Committee observed as under: In 351<sup>th</sup> meeting 27 ,oct.2022. the committee took a decision to file Review / appeal against the order for process the file as per 2009 Regulation (ignoring composite) in shivam college of education , and again in 354 meeting(13 Nov.2021)and all the orders by virtue of which the Hon'ble court directed</p>



			<p>NCTE to overlook 2014 Regulations while processing the pending applications.</p> <p>Besides NOC and composite requirement, there is a difference in duration of the course (B.Ed.– one year to two year-) faculty requirement and the qualification of the faculty. In view of above it is not permissible under the current regulations to process the application on the basis of 2009 regulations.</p> <p>In addition to above as per clause 13 of 2014 regulation</p> <p><i>"13. Repeal and savings -</i></p> <p><i>(1) The National Council for Teacher Education (Recognition Norm and Procedure) Regulations, 2009 is hereby repealed.</i></p> <p><i>(2) Notwithstanding such repeal, anything done or any action taken or purported to have been done or taken under the regulations hereby repealed shall, in so far as it is not inconsistent with the provisions of these regulations, be deemed to have been done or taken under the corresponding provisions of these regulations."</i></p> <p>It further clarifies that the said application shall be processed as per 2014 Regulation solely.</p> <p>In addition to above the Hon'ble Supreme Court also vide SLP Civil no(s) 4247-4248/2009 Rashtrasant T.M.S &amp; S.B.V.M.C.A. VID &amp; Ors V/s Gangadar Nilkant Shende &amp; ors Dtd. 10/09/2013 directs NCTE to process the pending/new applications with 2014 regulations of NCTE.</p> <p>1. Even the amendment in NCTE 2014 notification 22.10.21 states</p> <p><i>"3. The following clauses shall be inserted namely: -</i></p> <p><i>"(ca) "multidisciplinary institution "means a duly recognised higher education institution involving several different subjects of study/ combining or involving more than one discipline. Multidisciplinary universities and colleges will aim to establish education departments, which decides carrying out cutting edge research in various aspects of education, will also run Integrated Teacher Education Programme, in collaboration with other departments of filed of liberal arts or</i></p>
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			<p><i>humanities of social sciences or commerce or mathematics, as the case may be, at the time of applying for recognition of Integrated Teacher Education Programm</i></p> <p>The committee was informed that the Appeal has not been yet filed .Committee expressed its concern</p> <p>It is once again reiterated by the committee that appeal be filed on the issue of composite immediately.</p>
4.	--	<b>Handling of Legal Matters in various courts</b>	<p>The committee directed RD that the Standing Counsel should be advised to get mark the cases to the panel counsels by the Regional Director, so that they will aware about the case and provide timely information to the concerned Panel Counsel to defend the case in proper manner.the Panel counsel should be given complete factual report of the case by the office to put before court Therefore, a letter be issued to the standing counsels that procedure decided by NCTE to handle the cases in court should be followed</p>
