

B.Ed.	<p>The original file of institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulation and guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time were carefully considered by NRC in light of order dated 22.08.2023 passed by Hon'ble High Court of Delhi passed in W.P. C No. 11129/2023 and the committee observed the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The recognition was granted to the institution for B. Ed. Course for one year duration with an annual intake of 100 students vide recognition order dated 05.08.2004.• The recognition granted to the institution was withdrawn by the NRC vide withdrawal order dated 06.01.2010.• The institution filed appeal before the Appeal Committee of the NCTE against the withdrawal and the Appeal

				<p>Committee accepted the appeal of the institution and remanded back the matter to the NRC with the direction to pass restoration order vide order dated 29.04.2010. But no restoration order was passed by NRC at that time.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• No Affidavit was submitted as per Regulations, 2014 which was mandatory for issuance of RRO.• No Revised Recognition Order(RRO) was issued to institution, because of Non Submission of affidavit by the institution.• The matter was put and considered by NRC in 397th meeting of the NRC held from 18th to 19th April 2023 and the NRC decided to issue SCN to the institution. Accordingly, SCN was issued to the institution.• The institution submitted the reply to the first SCN and the reply was considered by NRC in its 403rd meeting held on 13th and 14th July 2023. The NRC decided to issue Final SCN to the institution. The NRC also decided to ask the University that on what grounds affiliation was continued to the institution after withdrawal of B.Ed. course without restoration of recognition.• As per decision of NRC in its 403rd meeting held on 13th and 14th July, final SCN was issued to the institution.• The institution filed the aforesaid writ petition before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi against the issuance of the Final SCN.• The Hon'ble court vide order dated 22.08.2023 disposed of the writ petition and directed the NRC to issue restoration order to the institution. The court in its order further directed that the recognition of the petitioner is treated to be restored for all practical purposes, unless the same is not specifically canceled or withdrawn by the concerned NRC.

			<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The court also directed the NRC to issue restoration order with in period of 10 days from the date of receipt of the copy of the court order. • As far as the final SCN is concerned, the court gave liberty to the institution to file appropriate reply to the final SCN issued to it. The court further directed the NRC to consider the reply submitted by the institution and to decide as to whether the recognition of the institution requires to be withdrawn or not. <p>In view of the above, the NRC decided the following;</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The restoration order be issued to the institution as per the directions of the court. 2. As per the directions of the court the institution is required to submit the reply of the final SCN issued by NRC, within time. <p>The file should be presented before NRC in its very next meeting for decision on final SCN.</p>



			<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The University is required to submit the certified copy of land documents of both the university established and the institution.• The university is required to provide the documents stating whether the university and the established institution is running within the same campus or not.• Any other document of Govt. of Uttar Pradesh in support of your request of change of affiliating body.• The decision of Major S D Singh Vishwavidyalaya to establish the Education Department in the university and merger of Babu Singh Daddu Ji Krishi Mahavidyalaya, Krishna Nagar (Badhar) Kanpur Road Fatchgarh Farrukhabad and courses run by the college. <p>Hence, the NRC decided that a letter be issued to the institution and the University concerned i.e. Shri Babu Singh Daddu Ji Krishi Mahavidyalaya and Major S D Singh Vishwavidyalaya (University) for reply of above points within 15 days.</p>
