

Again, Number of Complaints was received from Rajeshwaari Devi against the institution on the ground of Forged CDL and Land documents between 18.01.2019 to 07.08.2019 and online on 25.07.2020.5. The committee appointed VT for verification of Land Documents. But VT could not recommended clearly and specifically about land documents.6. Then NRC took decision to send the land documents to District Magistrate Varanasi for verification in 332nd Meeting of NRC..7. A letter dated 21.06.2022 was received from the District Magistrate, Varanasi verifying that CLU and other documents. But there was not mention about certified land documents.8. Thereafter the First SCN was issued to the institution on 28.06.2021 regarding compliance of RPRO. The Institution submitted reply on 28.07.2021.9. The committee observed the institution has not submitted a certified copy of the Registered Land Documents (Sale Deed/Gift Deed).10. Land documents submitted by Institution for transfer of ownership are also not registered.11. It is also observed that the land is disputed and matter is Sub-judice in the Hon'ble District Court of Varanasi (Santosh Kumar Singh Vs Mahadev College of Education).


