

**Minutes of 345<sup>th</sup> (Virtual) Emergent Meeting of the NRC, NCTE held on 16 September, 2021**





				<p>the disposal of the matter by the NRC on remand, the petitioner institution is entitled to be treated as a recognise institution.</p> <p>2. The respondents are also directed to communicate the revised status of the petitioners to the affiliating body as well as the state Governments.</p> <p>In view of the above, the committee decided as follows:</p> <p>A letter dated 09.08.21 was issued to the affiliating university and Department of Higher Education whereby it was stated that "a letter be issued to the concerned affiliating university as well as state government intimating the recognition status of the institution for allotting the students for the session 2021-22".</p> <p>It should be noted that "session 2021-22" was inadvertently typed and is hereby omitted.</p> <p>In the light of the Hon'ble court's order the status of the petitioner-institution is hereby restored as recognized until the disposal of the matter by NRC.</p>

B.Ed.	<p>In the compliance of the order dated 03.08.2021 of the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi at New Delhi vide W.P. ©6638/2021 the Committee has considered the decision and took the following decision as per NCTE Act 1992, Rules and Regulation 2014:</p> <p>1. The Hon'ble Court has directed that the petitioner has made out a prima facie case for the grant of interim relief. Neither the Act Nor the Regulations contain any power of review or stay of the</p>






				<p>nature exercised by the NCTE. It is well settled that no such power inheres in a statutory authority and must be conferred upon it. In fact, in the SOP, it is specifically provided that the Regional Committee shall not review or re-open any of its decision after confirmation. The impugned decision of the NRC cannot, therefore, be traced to any statutory source.</p> <p>2. Having regard to the aforesaid the respondents are directed not to give effect to the impugned decision dated 08-09.07.2021 until the next date of hearing. The impugned decision will not come in the way of the petitioner's affiliating University in proceeding with the petitioner's application for affiliation.</p> <p>In view of the above, the committee decided as follows:</p> <p>1. The Show Cause Notice No. NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP5585-B.Ed/342<sup>nd</sup> (Virtual)Meeting/2021/215624-626 dated 16<sup>th</sup> September, 2021 was issued to the institution inadvertently which is hereby withdrawn.</p>
