

The institution has submitted an application for grant of recognition to the D.El.Ed programme through offline mode on 30.10.2008 alongwith a copy of Private Lease Deed.2. The Private Lease Deed was accepted from 27.12.2005 to 27.11.2007 as per NCTE Regulations, 2005 and NCTE Regulations, 20073. After 27.11.2007 no Lease Deed from private party had been accepted by the NCTE. whereas, the institution submitted its application on 30.10.2008 i.e. after the last of 27.11.2007.4. The application was rejected on 14.04.2015 on the ground that the Lease Deed from the private party is not accepted as per existing NCTE Regulations because there is no provision in the existing regulations to accept the Lease Deed from private party.5 There is no provision in NCTE Regulations, 2009 to accept the Lease Deed from private party.6 The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India vide its order dated 10.09.2013 ordered as under: <i>"Those who are desirous of establishing teacher education colleges/ institutions shall be free to make application in accordance with the new regulations. Their applications shall be decided by the competent authority keeping in view the relevant statutory provisions. All the pending applications shall also be decided in accordance with the new regulations."</i>5. As per directions of the above-mentioned order of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India the new Regulations 2014 were notified on 28.11.14.


